As the G&S follows the rectified Constitution of ICE Hong Kong Association, Version March 2023, each future session shall comprise the period from one AGM to the succeeding AGM. The AGM of the G&S shall be organised prior to the AGM of ICE Hong Kong Association. The G&S AGM is scheduled for 5 June 2026. More details will be provided in due course. If ten or fewer valid nominations are received, all nominees are deemed to be automatically elected. Otherwise, a ballot will be held, and every Graduate and Student Member of the Institution residing in Hong Kong will be invited to vote. The nomination results will be posted on the ICE Hong Kong website on or before Wednesday, 25 March 2026, or after validity of nominations has been verified, whichever is later.
